- Provide a close relationship allowing access to God's presence.

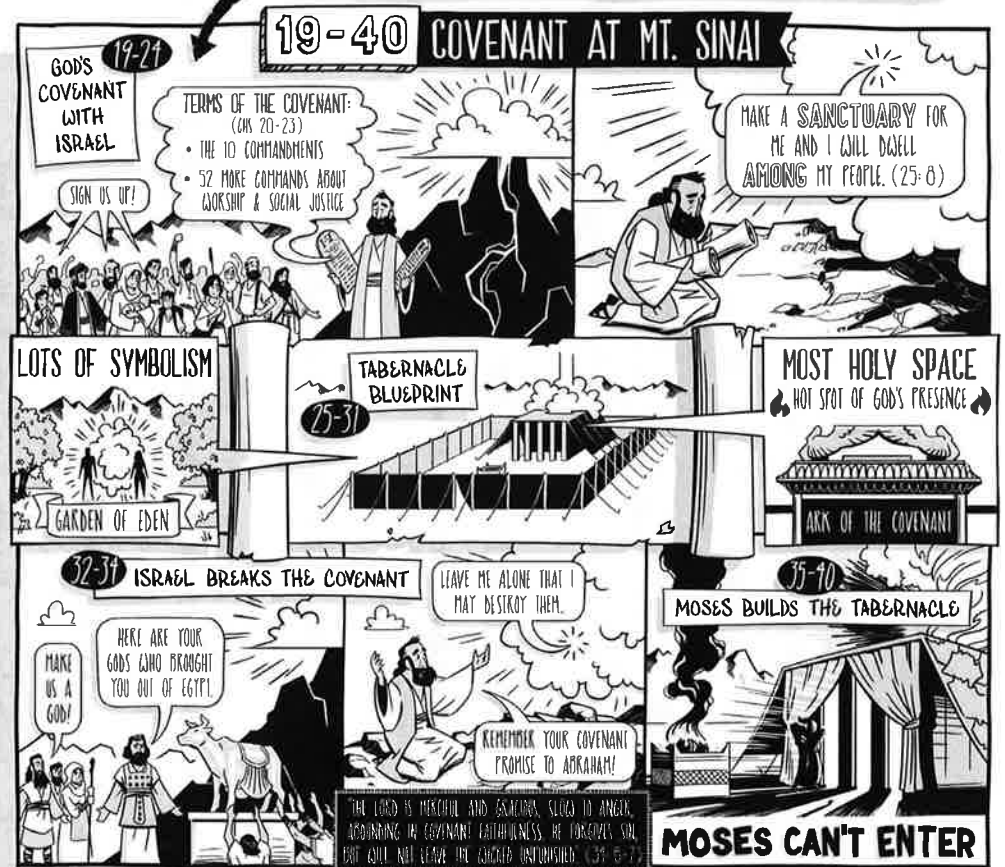
8. As Moses comes down the mountain what does he find the people doing?

- Why did God keep on giving them more and more laws (613 of them)?

First laws given → Don't have other gods → Israel breaks the law

More laws → More Rebellion, etc

o Jeremiah → Obedience wouldn't be a duty it would be written on their hearts
