NEW—Preparing For Worship—February 11

It's Life Sunday. God has given life to you and to your neighbors. No single life is more valuable than another. As people affirm this truth when they call out #metoo, we rightly reply in support #themtoo. But our affirmation of life's value includes not only those who have faced past abuse, but also those who can't say "me too" for themselves. To prepare for worship, read Romans 5:18-21 & Luke 10:25-37.

NEW—Preparing for Ash Wednesday & The Lent Season

This week, Christians begin Lent. This Season of the Church Year is a time of renewal and preparation for the celebration of Easter. It has become a very meaningful time for many of us. Use these 40 days to focus on the center of your faith – Jesus and His death and resurrection for you. And then reflect on your relationship to Jesus and His plan for your life. It is so easy to get sidetracked by what is happening all around us in our personal lives that we forget Jesus, who is really the center of life. He is what is really important.

The name Lent is probably derived from the Anglo-Saxon word meaning Spring...the time when days lengthen. The early Christians remembered with special devotions the 40 hours during which the Savior lay in the tomb. The period of commemoration was later extended to two weeks (Passion-tide), and eventually, in recognition of the 40 days of Jesus' temptation, to 40 days. Since Sundays were never fast days, being in Lent but not of Lent, four weekdays were added to the six weeks and this (probably during the time of Gregory the Great) finally fixed the Season of Lent as 40 fasting days. (This historical information is from The Lutheran Liturgy by Dr. Luther Reed.)
