The first sermon of Jesus is His shortest, but perhaps most important. The King-ing of God is touchable. The reign of God is now accessible to humanity. More than anything else in the gospels, Jesus proclaims that God's kingdom is here. God is present and at work. Do we have eyes to see it and ears to hear it? To prepare for worship, read Mark 1:1-20.

When Jesus first shows up in the public eye, he identifies himself as the long-awaited King of the world and asserts that his active rule and reign has begun. What does that look like in our day to day lives? What is this Kingdom anyway? Let's pray that we'll have eyes to see and ears to hear, so that we don't miss why God's reign rules.
